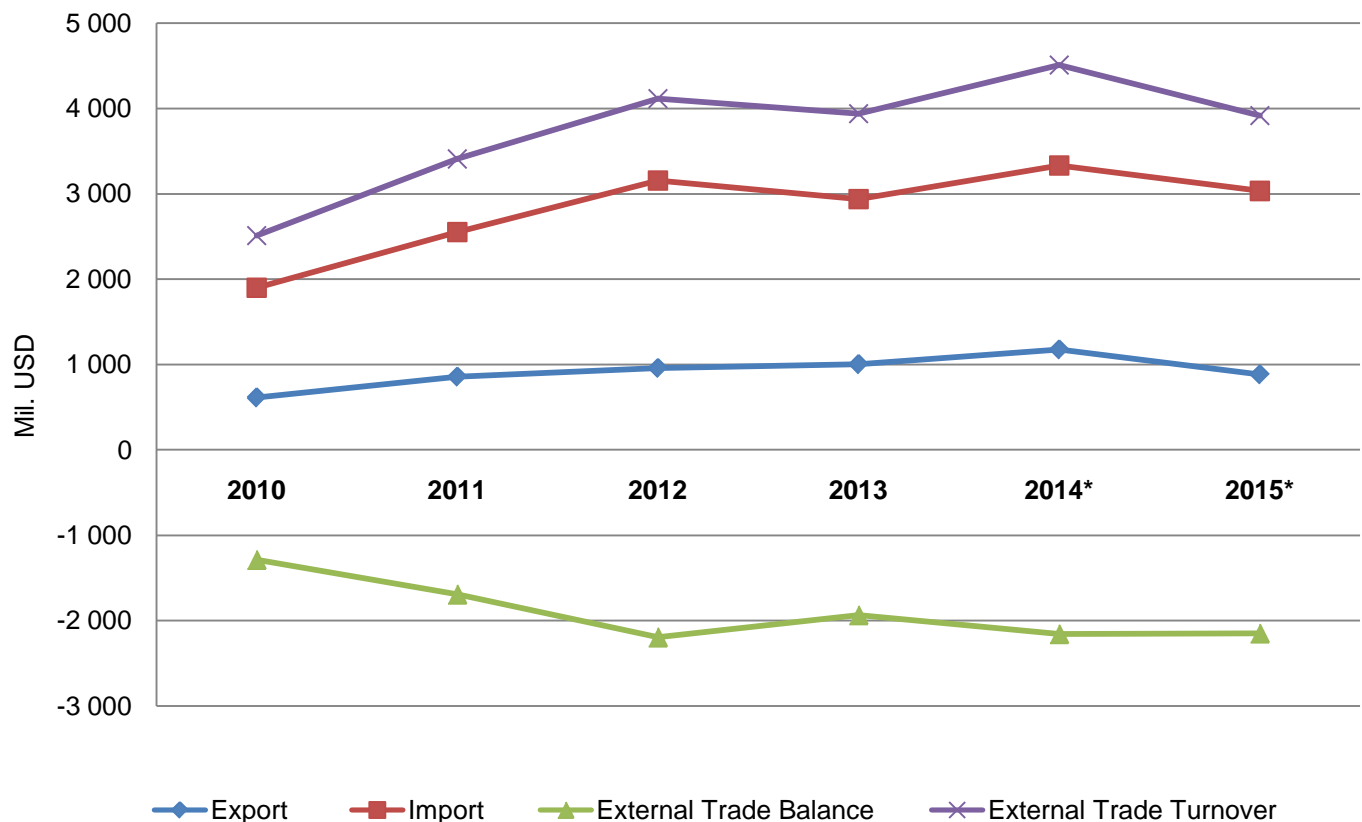

External Merchandise Trade of Georgia in January-May 2015 (Preliminary)

External Merchandise Trade (excluding non-organized trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 3917 million in January-May 2015 (preliminary data), decreased by 13 percent from the same month of the previous year. The value of export decreased by 25 percent reaching USD 884 million, while the import decreased by 9 percent and amounted to USD 3033 million with respect to January-May of the previous year. The trade deficit equaled USD 2150 million and its share in trade turnover constituted 55 percent
